

Leslie Ford Weber joined Suburban as Executive Vice President of the Suburban Hospital Foundation in 2004 and was also named Senior Vice President of Government and Community Relations for Suburban Hospital in 2008. During her tenure, average contributions to Suburban Hospital rose to more than \$7.5 million annually from an annual average of \$4.3 million in the preceding five years and the number of total donors to the organization has risen steadily.
